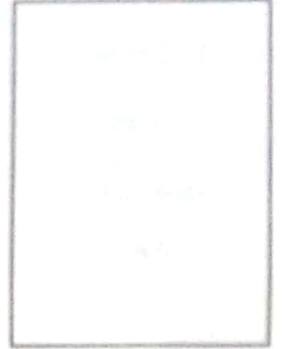

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- AARYAN COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, Om Vihar, Ph-1, Aaryan Garden Road, Opp. Metro Pillar No. 706, Uttam Nagar, New Delhi-59 is recognized by NCTE (Govt. of India) and affiliated to SCERT (Govt. of Delhi), hence all the conditions of NCTE and SCERT are applicable and mandatory for pursuing D.E.I.Ed/DPSE Course.
- The timings of the institute for DPSE/D.E.I.Ed classes are from 09.00 am - 4.00 pm
- Uniform is compulsory for every pupil teacher.
- 85% attendance is must for appearing in the annual examination. The attendance will be taken by the class teacher as well as subject wise.
- Any damage to the property of the institute will be borne by the concerned candidate.
- Participation in sports, co-curricular activities and excursions is mandatory.
- Late comers, uniform defaulters and irregular will be penalized.
- For medical leave, the certificate of Govt. Hospital will be valid.
- Fee is to be deposited through cheque or cash to the principal latest by 10th of concerned quarter failing which fine will be imposed as per rule.
- School experience programme (SEP) is mandatory for all the students with 100% attendance.
- Submission of various assignments given by the concerned subject teachers is essential as the internal assessment marks would be based on these assignments.
- It is mandatory to appear in the pre-final examination, failing which students may not appear in the final examination.
- It is mandatory for all the students to obtain No Dues Certificate form different branches/teachers for issuance of Admit card, failing which admit card will not issued.
- Assembly is compulsory as the attendance would be taken at the time of assembly.
- No student will leave the premises without written permission of the principal.
- No half day leave will be granted except in medical or emergency cases.
- Students are advised to see the Notice Board for various Notification Circulars issued by the institute.
- Participation of parents in PTM's is mandatory. The PTM will be held twice in a year in case they want to meet the principal or the class teachers they can send prior information and fix on appointment with them.
- The institute has the provision of Book Bank. Students may take benefit of it.
- The library books are to be returned back by the prescribed date, failing which fine will be imposed.
- A student needs to submit their mobile phones to class teacher at the time of assembly.
